Anthony Bracco and his family live in Cedar Grove NJ. While running his graphic design business for nearly 30 years, five years ago he and his wife bought a 25- acre farm in the Black Dirt region of Pine Island, NY. Anthony had intended to be a hobby farmer on just an acre growing his family the cleanest produce possible using Non-GMO seeds, hand cultivation of weeds, old-fashioned farm equipment, picking only when ready, and without chemicals, fertilizers, irrigation, pesticides, herbicides, glyphosate allowing the beautiful Black Dirt soil to naturally regenerate each season. These simple, obvious, time-honored sustainable farming techniques produced a shocking abundance of produce. And so, after just one season, Bracco Farms was born out of that demanding momentum of the growing food movement.
